2009 SJCF FESTIVAL COMPETITIONS

The attached entry form, should be completed as appropriate, signed and returned, with a Club entry fee made payable to 'SJCF' plus your Club's membership application to the 100 Club (if not already a member). No entries will be accepted **after 15th May 2009**. Fixtures to be published by 8th June 2009.

FORMAT : All ages Festival weeks will be played with the **BOWL** competition for the **better standard** teams, and the **SHIELD** competition for those fielding **younger/improving sides**. Clubs may chose which competition to enter (both if they wish). All 2009 County players **MUST** play in the Bowl at any age level.

FINALS : Teams will play in their groups to determine the group winner, based on normal 'win/draw/lose' points. Group winners will then be compared, initially using the average points per game gained in their week's group games, to determine whether they progress to the Festival Final on the Sunday of each week. Both Bowl and Shield competitions will have their own finals, but there will be no runners-up Finals.

PLAYERS : Ages to be taken as at 1st September 2008. All players must be genuine paid-up members of the junior section of the entering club, and cannot be 'imported' especially for, or represent more than 1 club in, this competition.

MANAGERS : will be provided by SJCF on request to those Clubs who could not otherwise participate in the Festival competitions, at a cost to the Clubs of £ 11 per Manager per Day.

UMPIRES : will be provided by SJCF at all competition finals. Clubs may also request SJCF umpires (at no cost to the Clubs) for any of their group games.

VENUES : Group games at Clubs' own grounds. All Finals at grounds to be specified by SJCF.

BOWLERS : There will be a restriction in the overs per bowler for each innings in all games, in accordance with ECB and SJCF directives.

HOME TEAMS : It is your responsibility to ensure that the visiting side will turn up, AND to phone-in the result of the match to the competition organisers on the day it was played.
