



SUSSEX CRICKET BOARD

Terms of Reference for the

Adult Leagues Group

1. The Adult Leagues Group [ALG] shall be accountable to the SCB Management Committee and accordingly the constituent leagues shall be accountable to the SCB through the ALG. It shall comprise 2 representatives from each of the adult cricket leagues within the county. Each league shall annually nominate 2 named individuals and 1 reserve.
2. The ALG shall meet a minimum of three times a year.
3. The ALG shall elect annually a Chairman, who shall be a member of the SCB Management Committee.
4. The objectives of the ALG shall be to:
 - advise and make recommendations to the SCB Management Committee on issues concerning leagues individually or collectively (e.g. future pattern and structure of league cricket);
 - implement the Sussex Cricket Board's strategy for the structure of adult league cricket in the county;
 - provide leadership, direction, advice and support to the leagues, both individually and collectively;
 - consult with the respective officers/managers of its members leagues in respect of matters of collective interest (e.g. disciplinary policies, playing formats, ground criteria, cricket balls, etc.);
 - ensure that the constituent leagues adopt and implement all ECB guidelines and directives (e.g. welfare, discipline, bowling regulations, wearing of helmets, etc.).
